## Lt. Governor Ramsey appoints Leadership Knoxville President and CEO to Ethics Commission

(Nashville) – The state Senate today unanimously confirmed the appointment of Tammy White as the state’s newest Ethics Commissioner. Ms. White was appointed by **Lt. Governor Ron Ramsey (R-Blountville)**. The commission is dedicated to increasing government integrity and transparency through the regulation of lobbying activities and financial disclosure requirements.
